the spread of this virus," said Timothy A. Buit, President and Chief Executive Officer of The Bellevue Hospital. "This latest surge is taking a toll on our hospital, emergency department and our TBH Family of healthcare heroes. Please help us by wearing your mask in public and getting the COVID-19 vaccination. This will help to protect you, your loved ones and our community."

#### Eligible individuals can call 419.484.5967 directly to make an appointment.

Pre-registration is required to receive the vaccine. Walk-in appointments are currently not available. Anyone under the age of 18 must have a parent or guardian with them. All patients should wear their own face covering upon arrival to the appointment.

You may be asked to leave a voicemail when calling the vaccine scheduling phone line. Please be assured that a TBH staff member will return the call to schedule your appointment.

Per the Ohio Department of Health, individuals ages 12 and older (with parent or legal guardian consent) are now eligible to receive the Pfizer vaccine, which is the only COVID-19 vaccine currently authorized for use for people ages 12 – 17. Currently, no COVID-19 vaccines have been approved for use in children under the age of 12.

# Prevent the Flu this Fall and Winter

According to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), it's likely that flu viruses and the virus that causes COVID-19 will both spread this fall and winter. This means getting a flu vaccine during 2021 - 2022 is more important than ever. The Bellevue Hospital is offering seasonal flu shots to the general public during annual flu shot clinics.

To help maintain proper physical distancing, individuals must now call and schedule an appointment to attend one of the scheduled flu shot clinics. Walks-in will not be accepted.

Flu shots are available for those ages 18-64. Cost is \$30.00 for the regular vaccine. A high dose vaccine for ages 65 and older is \$68. The shots will be fully covered for those with Medicare Part B or Medicare Advantage cards only. Those who are eligible must present their Medicare Part B/Medicare Advantage card prior to receiving their flu shot. No Medicaid or private insurance will be accepted to cover the cost. Cash, check, credit card or Medicare Part B/Medicare Advantage Cards only.

The flu vaccine does not cause the flu and pregnant women should consult their doctor before receiving the seasonal flu shot. Also, anyone who is allergic to eggs should not receive the vaccine.

# **TBH Now Offers Direct Access Lab Testing**

Monitor Your Health More Frequently and Conveniently

The Direct Access Testing program at The Bellevue Hospital allows you to order your own laboratory tests at an affordable price when you want them – without a physician's order. Direct Access Testing is available at TBH's main laboratory inside the hospital, located at 1400 W. Main Street in Bellevue.

### Hours for TBH's outpatient laboratory services are:

Monday – Friday 6:30 a.m. – 5:00 p.m. Saturday 6:30 a.m. – 1:00 p.m.

Direct Access Testing is for non-urgent, wellness blood work. It is not intended for participants with serious medical conditions that require close monitoring by a primary care provider.

Appointments are not necessary, but pre-registration is required. To pre-register, call 419.483.4040, Ext. 0.

Direct Access Testing will not be coded or billed to insurance and

must be paid for at the time of the service. Check and debit/credit card payments are accepted. See below for testing and pricing:

- Complete Blood Count with Basic Metabolic and Lipid Panel - \$50
- Hemoglobin A1C \$20
- Lipid Panel \$20
- Pregnancy \$15
- Prostate Screen (PSA) \$30
- Thyroid Stimulating Hormone (TSH) \$25
- Vitamin D \$35

Please note that some tests require a 10 - 12 hour fasting prior to the testing.



# **Using Artificial Intelligence for Better Breast Cancer Detection**

Built with the latest in artificial intelligence, it rapidly and accurately analyzes each 3D mammogram image, detecting cancers with unrivaled accuracy. It provides crucial information to our radiologists and alerts them if suspicious areas may warrant a closer look.

#### How does this technology benefit women?

ProFound AI for DBT is clinically proven to improve cancer detection by 8% and reduce the rate of false positives and unnecessary recalls for women by 7%.
